

REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS Market Street East Headhouse Renovations



PROJECT SCOPE

Background:

Market Street East historically has been the prime retail corridor of Center City. With the suburban migration in the mid-20th century Market East, Center City and Downton retail declined. In the 1980's and 1990's the City and CCD undertook improvements to the corridor to stimulate redevelopment. Some of the improvements at that time included: pedestrian lighting, sidewalk pavers, transit and landscaping.

Over the past 30 to 40 years these amenities have fallen victim to age and deferred maintenance.

With the 250th anniversary of the country, FIFA and other 2026 events, The City and the CCD have worked to develop a list of projects to revitalize this important corridor between Independence Mall, the Convention Center, City Hall, Benjamin Franklin Parkway and South Broad Street.

The headhouse renovations are one key element of the renovations planned for 2026 and will need to be completed by March of next year.

Scope of Services:

The project may include, but not be limited to, the following activities and work:

- 1. Limited design services for new lighting and ceilings,
- 2. Shop drawings and other services necessary to detail the work,
- 3. Cleaning of all equipment, and preparation of all surfaces (minus the porcelain ribbon, sign panel),
- 4. Evaluation of metal surfaces and conditions and recommend necessary repairs to the CCD.
- 5. Evaluate roof and gutter systems, clean and repair as may be needed,
- 6. Recoat all metal surfaces with appropriate paints, primers, powder coating etc. that may be necessary to complete the project scope,
- 7. Replace select glass systems with new tempered, vandal resistant glass,
- 8. Film all glass surfaces from the flat canopy down with graffiti film on interior and exterior surfaces,
- 9. Maintain all pedestrian traffic (CCD and contractor may develop this together with Septa and the City), and
- 10. All intersection advertising display boards to remain operable and in unrestricted public view for the duration of the renovation.

Process:

This is a multi-step process and includes:

- 1. Request for qualified contractors (this phase and RFQ),
- 2. The CCD shall select the most qualified contractors who will be invited to participate in the RFP/Bid process,
- 3. The CCD shall review the RFP/Bid proposals and select the contractor to provide services as identified in the RFP/Bid Proposal packet, and
- 4. Contractors with SEPTA and or City of Philadelphia experience are encouraged to submit RFQ packets.

RFQ Return Submittal Online - July 16, 2025, 3:00 PM EST

RFP Schedule (Projected):

- Requests for Proposals (RFP's) will be issued to qualified contractors in Summer of 2025.
- Contract selection will take place in August, 2025.
- Project start date projected for September 2025.
- Project completion will be firm and is the end of March 2026.

SUBMISSION FORMAT

To be considered complete, qualifications packets must include the following in this order with title sheets on each section:

- 1. Cover sheet with project identification title and date,
- 2. Cover letter dated and signed by an officer of the company,
- 3. Table of contents page inserted before the qualifications packet,
- 4. Overview of the submitters team and years in business,
- 5. The submitters approach to this project,
- 6. List of teams and team members including PM and team member resumes,
- 7. Proposed list and schedule of deliverables outlined in the scope,
- 8. List of not more than 5 representative projects with information on location, cost and scale,
- 9. A list of not more than 5 recent clients on similar projects, reference and contact information, and
- 10. Complete qualification form (the pages following), attach to the end of the RFQ submittal under a title sheet titled "Qualification Form", project name and date RFP submitted).

RFQ responses are limited to 35 pages.
